## 4. Service \& Refuelling

Any competitor wishing to access the service area or the refuelling area during the competitive element of the event must stop for at least for 3 seconds at a well identified 'box' located at the entrance of the pit lane.
Any competitor exiting the pit lane during the competitive element of the event must stop for at least for 3 seconds at a well identified 'box' located immediately before the access to the track.
The time spent on any of these operations, as well as on servicing or refuelling the vehicle, will not be deducted from the total time of the competitor.

## 5. Duration of the event

For each competitor,

- the event will conclude 60 minutes plus 1 lap after the start or 75 minutes after the start whichever happens first.
- to be classified he must conclude a minimum of $50 \%$ of the laps of his class winner.
- only completed laps will be counted for the classification.
