#### Two-way radios

2-Way radios are premitted to operate only on government controlled and designated frequencies.

#### Customs

Competitors are responsible for clearing their own cars and spare parts through customs. Where possible, assistance may be given. However, at least 14 days' notice should be given if any assistance is required.

#### Visas

Visas to enter Qatar are required for several nationalities. Competitors requiring assistance in obtaining a visa must give at least 21 days' notice prior to their day arrival. Assistance cannot be guaranteed if this notice is not received in time.











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### Fuel - Refuelling & Tyres

#### Fuel - Refuelling

As per articles 61 and 62 of FIA RRSR.

All type of fuel must follow Appendix J Art. 252.9. (RRSR V3 Art. 62).

Official refuel zones will be located at the exit of the service park and at remote locations on the rally route indicated in the rally itinerary and in the road book.

With reference to FIA RRSR art. 61.3, the following commercial filling stations were designated by the organiser to be used by the competitors for refuelling along the rally route:

## Scrutineering, sealing & marking

#### Scrutineering, venue & time

Cars may be presented at scrutineering by a representative of the team.

See programme (SR Art. 3). A detailed schedule will be published by means of a bulletin.

Any delay on the presentation at the time control installed at the entrance of the holding area will result in the following penalties:

from 1 to 15 minutes	€ 100
from 16 to 30 minutes	€ 150
> 30 minutes	€ 200
> 60 minutes	Start may be denied

Cars must be presented at scrutineering with the competition numbers, rally plates and all advertising (compulsory and optional) affixed.

#### Scrutineering mandatory documents

- ·Cars' complete certified homologation
- ·SOS / OK board (DIN A3 format)

For each car of the **FIA Priority Drivers**, one spare gearbox and one set of spare differentials (front and/or centre and/or rear) may be used in each rally. These spare components and those fitted to the car will be marked/sealed at initial scrutineering. These cars must have their sump guards removed for sealing of gearboxes and differentials and be kept with the car for the purpose of weighting.

The installation of the tracking system will be checked at scrutineering.

On-board camera positions and mountings (see SRs art. 12.12) will be checked at scrutineering.













## Scrutineering, sealing & marking

#### **Mud flaps**

See ISC Appendix J, Article 252.7.7.

#### Windows

See ISC Appendix J, Article 253.11.

#### Driver's safety equipment

All items of clothing including helmets and FHR (Front Head Restraint) intended to be used, e.g. HANS devices, must be presented for scrutineering. They shall be checked for compliance with Appendix L, Chapter III.

#### Noise level

On special stages only, the possibility of bypassing the exhaust silencer is recommended, provided that the exit of the exhaust gases is in conformity with Appendix J and, for cars fitted with a catalytic converter, that the gases themselves pass through this catalytic converter. At any time on the road sections the noise level must be in conformity with Appendix J.

#### Special national requirements

#### Installation of safety tracking equipment

For every vehicle, it is mandatory to mount a tracking system, live satellite tracking, data recording and emergency signalling device that will be used to monitor the position, movement and status of all competing cars at all times during the rally. This apparatus will be provided by the organiser.

The installation of the provided tracking system will be checked at scrutineering.

Any misuse of the system(s) during the rally will result in the competitor being reported to the Stewards who may impose penalties which may go as far as exclusion.













## Start & finish procedures

#### Rally start

The official start of the rally will be at TC0 (Lusail Boulevard).

Cars must be driven by one of the drivers or a team representative to the pre-start holding area, where they will enter between 17.30h and 18.00h.

Any delay on the presentation at the time control installed at the entrance of the holding area will result in the following penalties:

from 1 to 15 minutes	€ 100
from 16 to 30 minutes	€ 150
> 30 minutes	€ 200
> 60 minutes	Start may be denied

The holding area will be under vigilance. Access to the holding area is limited to team members and media representatives with appropriate identification.

No service will be allowed inside the holding area.













### Start & finish procedures

#### Finish Procedures

The competitive element of the rally will conclude at TC13C. From this point, all cars are subject to Parc Fermé rules until the Parc Fermé is opened at the instruction of the stewards.

Competitors are reminded that attendance at the finish ceremony and prize giving is compulsory for all classified crews and crew members must wear their approved overalls.

In the event a car is not driveable for the above procedure, this must be reported to the clerk of the course and the crew members concerned must still attend the podium finish ceremony.

Immediately after the publication of the Final Classification and opening of the Parc Fermé a convoy will be organized for all classified rally cars from the Service Park to the location of the Prize Giving (Lusail Boulevard). Cars may be driven by the crew or by one team member.

Post-event Press Conference (for invited drivers only) will take place at 18.30h.

Prize Giving Ceremony will start at 19.00h. Cars will pass by the ramp in reverse order of the final classification.

After the conclusion of the ceremony cars will be released and may be driven back to the service park.













## Passes & plates stickers sample

#### Stickers sample guide



To be affixed on the rear window, to the service area with close pedestrian access to the service area.



To be affixed on the front, centered on the bonnet of the vehicle and will have 1 piece per entered competitor. this plate will allow the cars to be parked in close proximity to the service area with close pedestrian access.



To be affixed on the front, centered on the bonnet of the vehicle and each entered competitor will be allowed 2 service vehicles. This plate will allow the vehicle in the service park.

## Appendix 5 - drivers equipment / extract from FIA ISC appendix L

#### Helmets (appendix L, chapter III, art.1)

All drivers and co-drivers must wear crash helmets homologated to one of the following FIA standards:

- 8858-2002 or 8858-2010 (Technical List N°41),
- 8859-2015 (Technical List N°49),
- 8860-2004 or 8860-2010 (Technical List N°33), or
- 8860-2018 or 8860-2018-ABP (Technical List N°69)

## Frontal head restraint (FHR, appendix L, chapter III, art.3)

All drivers and co-drivers must use FIA approved FHR systems homologated to FIA standard 8858. Approved FHRs, anchorages and tethers are listed in Technical List N° 29.

See also helmet compatibility chart in Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3.3.

## Flame-restraint clothing (appendix L, chapter III, art.2)

All drivers and co-drivers must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard (Technical List  $N^{\circ}27$ ) or 8856-2018 (Technical List  $N^{\circ}74$ ).

Please pay special attention to the prescriptions of Art. 2 concerning embroidery and printing on flame-resistant clothing (manufacturer certificates etc.) as well as concerning the correct wearing of the clothing elements!

## Appendix 5 - drivers equipment / extract from FIA ISC appendix L

## Biometric devices (appendix L, chapter III, art.2.1)

Drivers may wear a device to collect biometric data during racing.

- •If the biometric device is integrated into a protective garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856, the garment shall be homologated to FIA Standards 8856 and 8868-2018.
- •If the biometric device is a stand-alone device, then the device must be homologated to FIA Standard 8868-2018 only. This device must be worn in addition to the garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856.

## Wearing of jewellery (appendix L, chapter III, art.5)

The wearing of jewellery in the form of body piercing or metal neck chains is prohibited during the competition and may therefore be checked before the start.










# Appendix 7 - service park area layout plan











#### **Shipping Procedure:**

1- All vehicles will be shipped as Non Hazardous Cargo.

#### (Fuel tank must be empty and battery disconnected).

- 2- Shipper of the goods must provide a full set of documentation for all items for customs purposes.
- 3- Your goods are not insured, Logistics Companies not responsible for damages and missing items.













# Import of vechicles, spare parts & shipping

## Transprtation rules

- -Fuel tanks, engines and all parts making contact with fuel must be emptied and drained as much as possible in order to avoid any risk of fuel and gas leak.
- -Fuel is considered Dangerous Goods and cannot be shipped in container or airplane.
- -Oil is not considered Hazardous Goods. As for the paperwork in Qatar we cannot use ATA carnet, so it is required to issue a Commercial Invoice & Packing list.
- -All batteries must be disconnected and insulated.
- -Please do not send any sprays/aerosols along with the cars & parts asthese are considered Dangerous/Hazardous Goods and will cause problems with local authorities.
- -We can provide a combined transport for shipping all these items and carpets/floor tiles, ahead by sea freight to keep cost at a minimum and provide and offer and alternative solution.
- -Also please do not send any other fluids such as contact cleaner, acetone, brake cleaner etc.


