Navigation devices

With reference to article 8.5 of supplementary regulations, the file with the geographical coordinates of all WPV will be downloaded by the organiser to a personal GPS equipment to be provided by each competitor at the briefing.

The device must be classified as a proper GPS (with menus and options like Routes, Waypoints, Tracks, etc...) and not as a city navigator meant for road use.

Important notice: when delivered to the organiser, GPS device must be cleared from any previous waypoint / route / logged track.

The GPS device will be returned to the competitor at the TC before the Start of the selective section of each round.

In order to allow the download of round 6 WPVs geographical coordinates, it is the competitor's responsibility to deliver his GPS device to the organiser at the Stop control of round 5 selective section.

Qatar Manateq Baja Final Classification

As per Article 31.3 of Qatar Manateq Baja regulations, to be classified in the general classification of 2019 Manateq Qatar Baja Championship, a competitor (driver or co-driver) must participate in round 6 of the series.

Prize Giving

Competitors are reminded that Round 6 will finish at Baladna Farm (Al Shamal Rd, exit 44). Prize Giving Ceremony for Round 5, Round 6 and for the general classification of 2019 Manateq Qatar Baja Championship will take place at the same location on Saturday, 30 November, at 15.30 h.
