

## 2020 MANATEQ QATAR NATIONAL BAJA GENERAL REGULATIONS

### 1. General conditions

---

- 1.1** Qatar Motor and Motorcycle Federation (QMMF) organises the 2020 Manateq Qatar National Baja (2020 MQNB) which includes the following awards:
- One MQNB championship for Drivers
  - One MQNB championship for Co-drivers
- 1.2** MQNB is organised in accordance with the FIA International Sporting Code, the 2020 FIA Cross-Country Rally Sporting Regulations, these General Regulations and the Supplementary Regulations of the event concerned.
- 1.3** The championship will be made up of a maximum of 5 rounds organised across the State of Qatar.
- 1.4** Characteristics of the events
- Each round will be run over desert terrain and will accommodate vehicles which comply, as appropriate, with FIA or national technical and safety regulations.
  - The maximum duration of a rally will be two days from the scrutineering until the posting of the final results.
  - The total distance of the special stages of a rally will be between 100 and 250 kms.

### 3. Calendar

---

- Round 1 – 23 February (2020 MQCCR / Leg1)
- Round 2 – 25 February (2020 MQCCR / First part of Leg 3)
- Round 3 – 27 February (2020 MQCCR / First part of Leg 5)
- Round 4 – 30/31 October
- Round 5 – 27/28 November

The organising committee reserves the right to modify the calendar and/or to cancel any round of the championship, particularly if less than 7 vehicles have been entered.

### 4. Definitions

---

2020 FIA Cross-Country Rally Sporting Regulations Article 2 applies.

For the application of any article of these General Prescriptions, to be considered as participant in a round a competitor must pass administrative checks and scrutineering, regularly check-in at TC1 and take the start of the selective section of that round.

## 5. Participation, Entry Form, Entry Fees

---

- 5.1** Anyone wishing to take part in a Baja counting for MQNB must send the official entry form duly completed to the rally secretariat before the date of entries closure. The entry form is attached to these General Regulations and available on the organizer's website [www.qmmf.com](http://www.qmmf.com).
- 5.2** 2020 FIA Cross-Country Rally Sporting Regulations Articles 16.2, 16.4, 16.5 and 18 apply.
- 5.3** The entry fees will be: 1000 QAR per round
- 5.4** Payment Details

- 5.5** Anyone registered to take part in a Baja counting for MQNB will be automatically registered for 2020 Manateq Qatar National Baja championship.

## 6. Insurance

The entry fees include third party insurance.

## 7. Eligible Vehicles

---

### 7.1 Classes

T1	T1s, providing they comply with scrutineering and safety eligibility
T2	T2s, providing they comply with scrutineering and safety eligibility
T3	T3s, providing they comply with scrutineering and safety eligibility
All vehicles must hold a technical passport issued by either the FIA or their own ASN	

- 7.2** Normally aspirated vehicles of all classes must be fitted with an air restrictor at least 3 mm long and with a maximum internal diameter of:
- 32 mm for vehicles up to 4000 cm<sup>3</sup>
  - 35 mm for vehicles up to 6000 cm<sup>3</sup>
  - 38 mm for vehicles over 6000 cm<sup>3</sup>
- 7.3** Supercharged engines of all classes must be fitted with a restrictor fixed to the compressor housing.  
All the air necessary for feeding the engine must pass through this restrictor, which must respect the maximum internal diameter (d) of:
- 39 mm for engines up to 5000 cm<sup>3</sup>
  - 43 mm for engines over 5000 cm<sup>3</sup> and up to 6000 cm<sup>3</sup>
  - 46 mm for engines over 6000 cm<sup>3</sup>

2020 FIA Cross-Country Rally Sporting Regulations Articles 19, 20 and 21 apply.

## **9. Administrative checks and Scrutineering**

---

2020 FIA Cross-Country Rally Sporting Regulations Articles 22, 23 and 24 apply.

Details regarding Administrative Checks and Scrutineering, including location, individual convocation times and cash penalty for late check-in, shall be given in the supplementary regulation of each event.

## **10. Starting order**

---

**10.1** The Clerk of the Course of each round will decide the starting order for its rally respecting the following sequence:

- FIA Priority drivers (Cross-Country and Regional Rallies lists)
- MERC Priority drivers
- Current classification of 2020 MQNB
- All other drivers

**10.2** 2020 FIA Cross-Country Rally Sporting Regulations Article 31 applies.

### **18.1 General Classification**

1<sup>st</sup> – 2 trophies

2<sup>nd</sup> – 2 trophies

3<sup>rd</sup> – 2 trophies

### **18.2 Group 1 Classification**

1<sup>st</sup> – 2 trophies and QR 5000

2<sup>nd</sup> – 2 trophies and QR 4000

3<sup>rd</sup> – 2 trophies and QR 3000

### **18.3 Group 2 Classification**

1<sup>st</sup> – 2 trophies and QR 5000

2<sup>nd</sup> – 2 trophies and QR 4000

3<sup>rd</sup> – 2 trophies and QR 3000

### **18.4 Group 3 Classification**

1<sup>st</sup> – 2 trophies and QR 5000

2<sup>nd</sup> – 2 trophies and QR 4000

3<sup>rd</sup> – 2 trophies and QR 3000

**18.5** If there are less than 3 participants in any category, this category will be merged/combined with another category.

## **19. MQNB Championship classification**

---

**19.1** At each event, considering the general classification, points will be awarded according to the following scale:

1 <sup>st</sup>	25 points
2 <sup>nd</sup>	18 points
3 <sup>rd</sup>	15 points
4 <sup>th</sup>	12 points
5 <sup>th</sup>	10 points
6 <sup>th</sup>	8 points
7 <sup>th</sup>	6 points
8 <sup>th</sup>	4 points
9 <sup>th</sup>	2 points
10 <sup>th</sup>	1 point

All other classified drivers will be awarded 1 point.

**19.2** For each competitor all results less one will be considered for the final classification.

**19.3** To be classified in the general classification of MQNB, a competitor (driver or co-driver) must register for and participate in the final round of the series.

## **20. Prizes & Awards of 2019 Qatar National Baja Championship**

---

**20.1** At the end of the season, the following prizes will be awarded according with the general classification of the Championship

1 <sup>st</sup> – 2 trophies	1 <sup>st</sup> – 2 trophies
2 <sup>nd</sup> – 2 trophies	2 <sup>nd</sup> – 2 trophies
3 <sup>rd</sup> – 2 trophies	3 <sup>rd</sup> – 2 trophies

**20.2** Prize money for General Classification

1 <sup>st</sup> – QR 80,000
2 <sup>nd</sup> – QR 60,000
3 <sup>rd</sup> – QR 40,000
4 <sup>th</sup> – QR 30,000
5 <sup>th</sup> – QR 20,000

## **21. Protests and Appeals**

---

2020 FIA Cross-Country Rally Sporting Regulations Article 61 applies.

### **21.1 Protest Fees**

Sum of the protest fee: QR 5000.

If the protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of a clearly defined part of the car (engine, transmission, steering, braking system, electrical installation, bodywork, etc.), the claimant must pay an additional deposit of QR 5000.

If the protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of different parts of a vehicle, the claimant must pay an additional deposit of QR 5000 minimum.

### **21.2 Appeal Fees**

Sum of the national appeal fee: QR 8000.
