3. Programme

Only competitors who have participated at least in one of the previous rounds of the championship will be eligible to score points. All the remaining competitors may not score points nor deprive eligible competitors of points.

Competitors may score points either participating in the international event (FIA Qatar International Baja) or in the National one running behind the main event.

7. Baja regulations

Except in cases defined by championship regulations, the supplementary regulations of 2022 Qatar International Baja apply entirely to all competitors of Qatar Off-Road Championship.

On Friday, 25/03, after the conclusion of the competitive part of Round 3, competitors in the National event are allowed to transport their vehicles to the service park or any other location.

There will be no holding area before the start of Round 4. Competitors must be present at the start of the event at the time indicated on the start list to be published after the conclusion of Round 3.

8. Navigation / Tracking / Safety equipment

A deposit of 1500 QR (one thousand five hundred) is required for the Stella / Tracking / Safety equipment, which is refundable at the end of the baja after the receipt of all equipment in good condition.

9. Classification

To be classified in Round 3 or Round 4 a competitor must

- validate at least 50% of the total number of waypoints plus 1
- finish the selective section(s) of the round within the maximum time(s) allowed
- (for Round 4 only) enter the final parc fermé.
