CHAMPIONSHIP GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. Article 5.7 – Veteran Trophy (update)

To score points for the Veteran Trophy in a round of 2023 QORC / moto, a competitor must

- be 45 years old minimum on 1st January 2023,
- register for the Veteran Trophy in the entry form,
- participate with a Class 1 motorcycle or a Class 2 vehicle.

There will be separate classifications for Class 1 Veteran Trophy and Class 2 Veteran Trophy.

2. Appendix 2 / Article 5 – CC Baja specific regulations / Starting order and intervals (update)

~~The starting order for a Cross Country Baja as well as the start intervals shall be detailed in the supplementary regulations.~~

Except for the two international rounds in the calendar (R3 and R4) where FIM regulations will apply, for any 2023 QOCR Cross-Country Baja

- the starting order will be decided by lottery draw at administrative checks.
- the start intervals will be 1 (one) minute between all riders.
