ROUNDS 3 & 4 - SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS (new)

1/ Introduction

Rounds 3 & 4 will be run in the frame of the National Event running behind of 2023 FIA Qatar International Baja (QIB).

With the exceptions presented in the below articles, all related 2023 FIA regulations as well as 2023 FIA QIB supplementary regulations will apply.

Only competitors who have participated at least in one of the previous rounds of the championship will be eligible to score points. All the remaining competitors may not score points nor deprive eligible competitors of points.

Round 4

Except in any exceptional case at the discretion of the Stewards or the Clerk of the Course, the administrative checks and scrutineering for Round 3 will be valid for Round 4.

3/ Itinerary

Competitors must run the full itinerary of the baja, road sections included.

As an exception, on Friday 17/03, after the conclusion of the competitive part of Round 3, competitors in the National event are allowed to transport their vehicles to the service park or any other location.

4/ Classification

Round 3

It starts at TC0 on Thursday and finishes at SS3 stop control on Friday afternoon.

Holding areas regulations (before TC0 on Thursday and before TC1B on Friday) must be respected.

There will be no parc fermé during Round 3.

The participation at the Ceremonial Start is not compulsory.

The classification of Round 3 will consider all results and penalties from TC0 to the finish of SS3.

Round 4

It starts at TC3E on Saturday and finishes at final parc fermé.

There will be no holding area before the start of Round 4. Competitors must be present at the start of the event at the time indicated on the start list to be published after the conclusion of Round 3.

The classification of Round 4 will consider all results and penalties from TC3E to the final parc fermé.

To be classified in Round 3 or Round 4 a competitor must

- validate at least 60% of the total number of waypoints
- finish the selective section(s) of the round within the maximum time(s) allowed
- not to cumulate more than 30 minutes of lateness at the different time controls
- (for Round 4 only) enter the final parc fermé.

5/ Navigation / Tracking / Safety equipment

A deposit of 1500 QR (one thousand five hundred) is required for the Stella / Tracking / Safety equipment, which is refundable at the end of the baja after the receipt of all equipment in good condition.
