

2023 QATAR OFF-ROAD CHAMPIONSHIP

Cars

Bulletin #7 (20.10.2023)

Following the cancellation of 2023 QORC / Cars Rounds 1 and 5 – the first two Survivals of the championship – due to insufficient number of participants, the Organising Committee decided to cancel the 2023 Survival Trophy and amend 2023 QORC General Regulations as follows:

CHAMPIONSHIP GENERAL REGULATIONS

Article 1.1 – Introduction

Qatar Motor and Motorcycle Federation (QMMF) organises the following competitions for cars:

- 2023 Qatar Off-road Championship for cars (2023 QORC / cars)
- 2023 Baja Trophy
- 2023 Baja Trophy for co-drivers
- 2023 Survival Trophy

Each round of the above competitions is organised in accordance with the FIA International Sporting Code, the 2023 FIA Cross-Country Rally Sporting Regulations (where applicable), these General Regulations and the Supplementary Regulations of the event concerned.

Depending on the competitions, ~~two~~ **one** types of events will be held:

- ~~“Survival” (see Appendix 1 for specific regulations)~~
- Cross-Country Baja (see Appendix 2 for specific regulations)

The organising committee reserves the right to modify the calendar and/or to cancel any round, particularly if less than 7 vehicles have been entered.

Article 5.5

Anyone registered to take part in a round of 2023 QORC / cars will be automatically registered and may score points for

- 2023 Qatar Off-Road Championship (cars)
- 2023 Baja Trophy ~~or Survival Trophy as applicable~~
- 2023 Baja Trophy for co-drivers, ~~if applicable~~

Article 17.1

In each round of 2023 QORC and Baja Trophy and Survival Trophy according to the class classification, the following points will be awarded:

1 st	25 points	6 th	8 points
2 nd	18 points	7 th	6 points
3 rd	15 points	8 th	5 points
4 th	12 points	9 th	4 points
5 th	10 points	10 th	3 points

All other classified drivers and co-drivers will be awarded 2 points.

All non-classified participants will be awarded 1 point.

The same scale of points will be used for Baja Trophy for co-drivers.

Article 17.2 - Coefficients

The points awarded in each round will be multiplied by the following coefficient:

Article 17.3 - Number of results considered for the final classification

- 2023 QORC – Number of rounds held less one; if less than 7 rounds are held, all results will be considered
- Baja Trophy – Number of rounds held
- Baja Trophy for co-drivers – Number of rounds held
- ~~Survival Trophy – Number of rounds held~~

17.4 Minimum number of participations

To be classified a competitor must participate in a minimum of

- 2023 QORC – 5 3 championship events
- Baja Trophy – 3 trophy events
- Baja Trophy for co-drivers – 3 trophy events
- ~~Survival Trophy – 2 trophy events~~
